Thank you for your interest in our Health Screening services. Our van is used for the purpose of community health screening. The mobile health screening van provides the following free health-screening services. **Any screenings offset in boldface type may require additional charges.** These services are offered in conjunction with schools, senior centers, malls, fairs, places of business and other community venues.

- **Full lipid panels**
 - Total Cholesterol (HDL, **LDL, Triglycerides**)
 - Fasting & Non-Fasting
- Glucose
 - Fasting & Non-Fasting
- Blood pressure
- Body Composition
 - Height & Weight
 - Waist Circumference
 - Body Fat Percentage
 - BMI
- Grip Strength
- Computerized Health Age Appraisal and other simple computerized assessments

Health professionals will be available, on site, to answer questions. We offer helpful literature that addresses general and specific health issues with recommended lifestyle changes that may positively affect health. Information will be provided regarding upcoming health education events sponsored by Adventist WholeHealth, such as *CHIP*, *Super Fit Family Challenge*, vegetarian cooking classes, stop smoking seminars, etc. If spiritual support is sought by any participant, it will be provided.

Individuals with abnormal findings will be referred to their primary care physician for follow-up management. In addition, Adventist WholeHealth staff will contact these individuals by phone or mail within six weeks after the health screening as per Pennsylvania Department of Laboratories regulations.

Our van is 26 feet long and requires an area large enough to accommodate both the van and awning. We will also need access to an electrical hook up. If this is not available, then you will need to notify us prior. The van will be staffed with Adventist WholeHealth employees and volunteers, but additional volunteers may also need to be provided. The number of volunteers will be determined after the type and number of activities is agreed upon. The sponsoring organization or is responsible for recruiting volunteers. There will be a volunteer orientation one hour before the event is to start. All volunteers will need to be present for training.

Each application will be considered on a first-come first-serve basis, subject to staff availability and prior community commitments. Applications must be submitted at least 2 months prior to the event.

Providing community health screenings free of charge is not without expense to Adventist WholeHealth. Staff salaries, van and equipment maintenance, lab supplies, and fuel are just a few of the expenses we will incur. Since Medicare does not cover health screening nor do most other health plans, the following fee is applied to cover some of the expenses. This will be billed to your organization after the screening has taken place.

(This is an addition to the \$25 application fee).

- **Within Berks County, \$30**
- **Over 25 miles from Berks County, \$50 plus \$.50 per mile**
